**Terms and Conditions:**

- \* CCA reserves the right to refuse an application.
- \* stallholders must provide evidence of a valid liability insurance cover, at least \$10m, send copy with application.
- \* stallholders accept that if the event is severely rain affected it will be cancelled.
- \* stallholders are responsible for clearing their stall space and surrounds of garbage.
- \*stallholders must take all reasonable care of the health and safety of themselves and others and must co-operate with NSC officers to comply with OHS standards.

**Code for temporary food premises:**

- \* stallholders selling food must comply with the Code for Temporary Food Premises.
- \* Information on the Code can be obtained by contacting NSC Environment & Health Regulations Dept., telephone - 9936 8100.
- \* North Sydney Council Inspectors may be present on the day. Action can be taken on non-compliance and/or refusal to obey Inspectors instruction.
- \*All non-biodegradable materials and cooking oils must be collected and removed at the end of the day. Drains lead to the harbour, they must not be used for oil/waste.

**Stall details:**

- \* the stall site fee is payment for 3m frontage x 3m deep on the grassed area of Bradfield Park. Extra space at pro rata may be available if booked in advance.
- \* weather protective structure must be weighted at the base or tied down.
- \* stalls will be set up fronting the line with 1m perimeter to allow free flow access.
- \* vehicles must be off-site by 09.15 and are not permitted on site during the event.
- \* shared stalls require an application from each party stating the intention to share.
- \* any special needs (eg: disability access, extra space, etc) must be mentioned with the application.

**Arrival at the event and end of day:**

- \* the program commences at 10.00 and ends 17.30.
- \* **the area opens for stallholders at 07.30, please arrive by 08.30 to minimise delay.**
- \* **entrance to the site is via Broughton Street. Upon arrival CCA stewards will direct you to your site, do heed their instruction.**
- \* the official end of day is 17.30, please do not pack-up until after that time (weather and crowd permitting). Arrangement (by request) may be made for extended stay after 17.30.
