
While there are no photographs available for Stephen and Caroline Webb who both died in the 19th Century, their sons Stephen and George, their wives and children, and their descendants are well represented. Stephen and George Webb both married daughters of Edward Andrew and Susannah nee Larbey so that the Andrew family is appears in these photographs.

Susannah Andrew nee Larbey



Susannah nee Larbey was the mother of Jane and Ann Emma Andrew. Thephoto on the left was likely to have been taken near the end of the 19th Century. The Photo of the Memorial Card to Susannah relates to her death on 28 September 1907 at the age of 77 years.

Mary Jane Webb, daughter of Stephen and Caroline Webb




Mary Jane Webb was the daughter and third child of Stephen and Caroline Webb.
